- 22. Do you check to see if all of your homes' windows are locked whenever you leave your home?
- 23. Have you placed a board or after market lock inside the track of sliding glass doors or windows?
- 24. Are all of the hedges, bushes and trees trimmed or cut back near windows and entrances so that a person could not be obscured while attempting to enter your home?
- 25. Have you placed alarm company stickers on your windows or property?
- 26. Are there exterior motion detector lights on the exterior of your home?
- 27. Do you make arrangements to have your lawn maintained while you are away?
- 28. Do you stop all mail and newspaper deliveries to your home while you are away?
- 29. Do you use automatic timers on lights, radios and TVs in your home?
- 30. Does your home appear lived in whether you are home or not?
- 31. Do you notify a family member or trusted neighbor, when you are going on vacation or leaving town?
- 32. Do you test the smoke detectors in your home on a regular basis?
- 33. Do you have a carbon monoxide detector in your home?
- 34. Do you have a detailed list of all your valuables, including serial numbers?
- 35. Have you photographed valuable items i.e. (jewelry) for identification purposes?
- 36. Do you have a working flashlight in your home and vehicles?
- 37. Do you turn the ringer volume down on your telephone while you are away?
- 38. If you are a new resident, have you had all the exterior door locks replaced or re-keyed?
- 39. Do you have a cellular phone available in case the telephone wires to your home are cut?
- 40. Do you and all of your family members know the emergency telephone number for the Mahwah Police Department?
